## CODE OF CONDUCT AGREEMENT

### CONDUCT

#### GENERAL GUIDELINES

General guidelines are for all Sound Foundation students and family members.

- \_\_\_\_\_ 1. Parents and students are expected to be respectful of individuals in authority and follow instructions at all times. This includes, but is not limited to, teachers, teacher assistants, hall monitors, leadership, and church staff.
- \_\_\_\_\_ 2. Students need to show respect in words and conduct to all adults and peers. Students should address adults respectfully, use manners, and common courtesy.
- \_\_\_\_\_ 3. Refraining from gossip is expected of all adults and children. Please address your concerns to the the director.
- \_\_\_\_\_ 4. Be respectful of all property where Sound Foundation Academy functions are held, at all times. Do not deface or destroy the property in any way. Treat all property and equipment with the utmost care.
- \_\_\_\_\_ 5. Please stay in the designated areas or classrooms during Sound Foundation functions. No unsupervised or unauthorized roaming will be allowed.
- \_\_\_\_\_ 6. No running or yelling inside any building during Sound Foundation functions.
- \_\_\_\_\_ 7. Please honor one another by being on time for all scheduled Sound Foundation events and/or classes you attend. Recurring tardiness to events will result in meeting with the director and the possibility of Sound Foundation membership being suspended.
- \_\_\_\_\_ 8. Do not speak profanities or vulgarities.
- \_\_\_\_\_ 9. Student cell phones and tablets are to be turned off and not used during Sound Foundation functions or field trips. Parents and teachers should adjust phones to vibrate only.
